

Terminal A Renovation Starts Final Phasing


Completion Date Drawing Near

With a May 2014 scheduled completion date, crews begin work on the final phases of Terminal A's \$35.6 million renovation project. To date, 16 gates have been completed with only one still under construction. New flooring has been installed in the gates and the walls and ceiling have received new finishes. The gate areas have also received new furniture, equipped with electrical outlets and USB ports for added convenience.

The renovation of all public restrooms and the visitor waiting room in ticket lobby have also been completed. Signage around the ticket counters has been completed and crews continue to make progress on the lobby's terrazzo floors. The baggage claim area has been completely updated with finishes similar to those found in Terminal B and is nearing completion. Work on the entry doors and terminal escalators continues so visitors should anticipate escalator and entry door closures as crews work to install new ones. Under this project, the concourse store fronts are being updated with new signage and finishes and work on the terminal's HVAC and fire sprinkler system continues to move forward.


The terminal food court areas are also undergoing major improvements. In addition to installation of terrazzo flooring and updates to the wall and ceiling finishes, lighting fixtures will be replaced. The food courts have already received new furniture. New concessions The Fruteria and Steak 'n Shake opened in late 2013 while Famous Famiglia has been temporarily closed for renovations and is expected to reopen in a couple months. Expansion to the UETA retail store is currently underway and customers should be able to shop in this newly updated and expanded area in the next couple of months. For now, a UETA kiosk is available in the concourse temporarily.

The Terminal A renovation project is being funded through user fees, rents, airline rates and charges and no local tax dollars are being used to operate or pay for the project. For more information on the Terminal A renovations, **visit SanAntonio-Airport.com**.
