



## SAN ANTONIO AND GUADALAJARA SIGN INTERNATIONAL AVIATION COLLABORATION

San Antonio, TX (November 6, 2014) – Officials from Guadalajara and San Antonio have now authorized an agreement between their international airports. Called an “International Aviation Collaboration,” the alliance formalizes the airports’ shared commitment to promote and facilitate tourism and business travel between the two cities.

“The alliance is an opportunity for mutual promotion and an exchange of best practices,” says San Antonio Aviation Director Frank R. Miller, “Furthermore, collaborations like this one have the potential to stimulate additional partnerships between the two cities.”

The signing ceremony in Guadalajara attended by officials from both airports, Guadalajara-area business leaders and aviation business partners from San Antonio, including Clay White, general manager of **Landmark Aviation**, and **Skyplace FBO** CEO Pablo Hoyos and France Schultschik, president of the **Schultschik Marketing Group** and International Committee Chair of the **San Antonio Hispanic Chamber of Commerce**. The San Antonio International Airport thanks its many partners who supported the event in Guadalajara, especially event sponsor **Landmark Aviation**.

The Guadalajara International Airport (GDL), also known Don Miguel Hidalgo y Castilla International Airport, is among Mexico’s busiest airports, with more than 8 million passengers annually.

Currently, **Interjet** and **Volaris** offer non-stop service between San Antonio and Guadalajara.

Ranked among the United States' busiest gateways to Mexico for commercial passenger service, SAT offers daily and weekly service to multiple Mexican destinations including Mexico City, Monterrey, Toluca and Guadalajara, which is served by both **Interjet** and **Volaris** airlines. **Southwest, Aeroméxico** and **VivaAerobus** also serve routes to Mexico from SAT. Starting April 8, 2015, daily service to Cancun will be offered by Southwest Airlines.

This accord is the third such agreement for SAT, which also has alliance relationships with Del Norte International Airport, (MMAN), Monterrey and Toluca International Airport (TIA).
