The Park at Sutton Oaks is the first official housing phase of the Choice Neighborhood Initiative. The \$29.4 million, 208-unit, mixed-income Park at Sutton Oaks is built to Build San Antonio Green (BSAG) Level II. The community features a swimming pool, fitness center, community room, children's activity center, community theater room, dog park, children's playscape and a community garden.

After the news conference and ribbon cutting, the dignitaries and residents joined in planting vegetables in the extensive community gardens.
