WOODLAWN LAKE PARK
VENDOR PROGRAM**

Rules and Regulations

Woodlawn Lake Park Vending Program Vendors and their employees must abide by the following rules and regulations at all times during their Vending Period:

1. Vendors must be compliant with all applicable State of Texas laws and regulations, including the Texas Food Establishment Rules.
2. Vendors must at all times be compliant with all applicable City of San Antonio rules and regulations.
3. Vendors must possess a current, valid Mobile Vending Permit issued by the City of San Antonio Metropolitan Health District and display this permit at all times while within Woodlawn Lake Park.
4. Vendors may sell pre-packaged prepared food items, pre-packaged food items and soft drinks, prepackaged ice cream, and sno-cones. However, Vendors may not sell any items not allowed under their City of San Antonio Mobile Vending Permit. No other foods or drinks may be sold.
5. Items prepared on site such as, but not limited to, nachos, hot dogs, frito pie, etc., are not eligible for vending.
6. No alcoholic beverages may be sold nor consumed within Woodlawn Lake Park.
7. Only vehicles approved by the Metropolitan Health District as part of the Mobile Vending Permit program shall be allowed. Those vehicles must be maintained in good, clean, and working condition. No pushcarts or afoot vending are allowed.
8. No tables, chairs, decorations, fixtures, furniture or equipment shall be placed outside of the vehicle.
9. No generators or propane tanks can be used, and Vendor may not utilize electrical connections within Woodlawn Lake Park.
10. Vendor shall keep the area around their vehicle free of trash.
11. Vendors may not “hawk” their products or approach park visitors to sell.
12. No amplification of music or voice or other loud noises shall be allowed; Vendors may play music at a level that cannot be heard by anyone other than themselves and their customers.
13. Vendors shall not bring animals or children 13 years or younger to the vending area.
14. Vendors shall be allowed to place a sign indicating the cost of all food and beverage items, however the sign must be located within the vending vehicle and the dimensions shall not exceed the size of the opening in the vending vehicle.
15. Physical altercations, loud or inappropriate language, or other actions considered by the City to be inappropriate to the Woodlawn Lake Park Vending Program will not be allowed.
16. Vendors must wear their City issued identification badge at all times when their vehicle is present at Woodlawn Lake Park.
17. Vendors must display their Woodlawn Lake Park Vending Program permit in their vehicle at all times.
18. During special events at Woodlawn Lake Park, City may temporarily suspend a Vendor’s right to vend. City shall provide prior written notification to Vendor in these situations.
19. Vendor must not leave their vehicle unattended at any time.
20. City shall have the right to inspect Vendor’s vehicle and vending site at any time.
