G. Application/Submittal							
<p>A plan review shall commence within a reasonable time after submission of a permit application and payment of fees. Upon the expiration of 180 days following the date of filing, said application shall be deemed to have been abandoned unless diligently pursued or a permit issued. With justifiable cause an applicant may request additional time and the <i>fire code official</i> may grant said request in periods not exceeding 90 days each. Plans and other data submitted for review may be returned or destroyed by the fire code official if the application is deemed to have been abandoned. In such circumstance, a new application package including new plans and review fees must be submitted.</p> <p>Submittals. Two (2) sets construction documents and supporting data shall be submitted with each application for a permit and in such form and detail as required by the <i>fire code official</i>. The <i>construction documents shall be prepared by a registered design professional</i> where required by the statutes of the jurisdiction in which the project is to be constructed.</p> <p>Information on construction documents. <i>Construction documents</i> shall be drawn to scale upon suitable material. Electronic media documents are allowed to be submitted when <i>approved by the fire code official</i>. <i>Construction documents</i> shall be of sufficient clarity to indicate the location, nature and extent of the work proposed and show in detail that it will conform to the provisions of this code and relevant laws, ordinances, rules and regulations as determined by the <i>fire code official</i>.</p> <p>Submit to : Fire Prevention 1901 South Alamo St San Antonio, Texas 78204</p>							

H. Certification

I understand that if a notice of violation has been issued for starting work without first obtaining an appropriate permit, the application fee will be ***doubled the of the original permit fee***, as provided in the adopted Fire Code.
