



Explore the Hugman River Walk Tour by using your smartphone and lose yourself in the River Walk that Robert H.H. Hugman brought to life in 1939. The QR Code (*below*) can be scanned from your smartphone or pad device, and it will navigate you to the various points of interest. Listen to the audio commentary by Lewis F. Fisher, author of *River Walk: The Epic Story of San Antonio's River*; view historical photos of the River Walk; and take part in the only interactive self-tour of the San Antonio River Walk!

The Hugman River Walk Tour highlights twelve key original Hugman features along the River Walk in downtown San Antonio. Each stop has a bronze seal (pictured at left), which serves as a physical marker to coordinate with the smartphone tour, history, pictures, and audio. Along the way, look for additional Hugman features marked by smaller bronze seals. The full tour takes about an hour and a half to complete with a moderate walking distance of approximately 1.75 miles one way, or 3.5 miles round trip.
