Documents recommended for shredding include: confidential paper: financial records, legal documents, medical records, invoices/receipts, tax returns, etc. The shredder will also accept hard drives/DVDs/back-up tapes/etc. but these will need to be shred off-site. No binders, hard back books, computer monitors or PCs, laptops. Staples, rubber bands or any paper fasteners do not need to be removed for shredding services.
