

Public Notice – Budget Public Hearing
City of San Antonio, Texas

Two Public Hearings will be held by the City of San Antonio City Council to receive comments on the City of San Antonio FY 2016 Proposed Property Tax Rate and the FY 2016 Proposed Operating and Capital Budgets. The Public Hearings will be held on Wednesday, August 19, and Wednesday, September 2, 2015. Both Hearings will be conducted in the City Council Chamber, 114 W. Commerce at 6:00 PM.

Residents wishing to speak at the Budget Public Hearings may individually sign a register for that purpose which will be provided at the entrance of the City Council Chamber beginning at 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, August 19, and Wednesday, September 2, 2015. Residents also can register on-line Wednesday, August 19, 2015 from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. and Wednesday, September 2, 2015 from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. at www.sanantonio.gov/clerk.

This budget will raise more total property taxes than last year's budget by \$44,027,644 or 10.27%, and of that amount, \$12,579,588 is tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year. Of the \$44,027,644 in added property tax revenue, \$25,217,021 is proposed to be used in the City's General Fund to support essential City services such as Police, Fire, Streets, Parks & Recreation and Code Enforcement. The remaining \$18,810,623 is proposed to be used for debt service payments on debt issued for capital projects. These amounts are based on the City's proposed Property Tax Rate of 55.827 cents per \$100 of assessed valuation. The City's FY 2016 Proposed Budget includes a City Property Tax Rate decrease.

The City's FY 2016 Proposed Budget is posted on the City's Website www.sanantonio.gov and available for inspection at the City's Central and branch libraries. Copies of the FY 2016 Proposed Budget are available for purchase and / or inspection in the Office of the City Clerk, 2nd Floor, City Hall. This meeting site is wheelchair accessible. The accessible entrance is located at the Municipal Plaza Building / Main Plaza entrance. Accessible visitor parking spaces are located at City Hall, 100 Military Plaza, north side.
